Aims and objectives	The X4L Music project involved in collaboration between Brockenhurst College and Farnborough College of Technology and looked at e-learning activities in an area of the curriculum not often involved in other national activities. The focus was on human processes rather than technical development. This project ended in December 2003.
	The RDN Virtual Training Suite offers free eLearning tutorials teaching Internet skills for different curriculum subject areas. The VTSX4L Project aimed to repurpose 5 HE tutorials for FE and explore the use of the Virtual Training Suite tutorials in VLEs. This project ended in October 2003.
	The X4L Lit project repurposed materials using the Literature Online (LION) collection from Proquest. Twelve learning objects were created based on a play, a poem and a piece of prose for use in GCSE, A-Level and informal learning courses. A highlight of this project was the development of a method of setting a free response assessment, called the FREE.
	In this session, representatives from each of these projects will explain the approach they took to their project, some of the key findings, the impact of their project and lessons learned.
