Aims and objectives	Scientists and researchers across the UK are generating large amounts of data through experimental methodologies, simulations and observational techniques. This volume is increasing dramatically with the advent of Grid-enabled applications, and the current challenge is to ensure that this data remains available and valid for future researchers. This session will introduce some contextual background by briefly examining the work that is being done by large scale escience and e-research initiatives and in considering some of the data curation issues that they face. The session will move on to outline the work of the Digital Curation Centre (DCC), to describe the relationship with the JISC Continuing Preservation and Access Strategy and with the work of the Digital Preservation Coalition. We will look in detail at the role of the DCC and its activities in the key areas of research, development, provision of advisory services, and the outreach and community support programme. We will also discuss the ongoing analysis of user requirements and seek to draw on the experience of the delegates attending, to ensure that the work of the DCC is meeting these requirements, both with regard to data creators/curators and re-users and policy makers and strategists.
