

## Assessing requirements for searches

### Aims Of This Exercise

This exercise is intended for use in a hands-on exercise and in discussion groups.

#### 1.1 Looking at search facilities available

For first 15 minutes, go to several web sites (at least 3), some that you know and others that you don't (include a large corporation such as a drug or industrial company and a government site), and try their search facility (and see if you can find out what it is). Ensure you look at at least one HE site in the UK and try one of
